Attleboro Woman pleads not guilty to accessory charge

The Attleboro woman accused of being an accessory to the murder of Dijoun Beasley at the South Shore Plaza last weekend pled not guilty at her Quincy District Court arraignment this morning, according to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey.

"Assistant District Attorney Anne Yas asked Judge Maurice Flynn to impose \$200,000 cash bail on Samantha Schwartz, and to have her subject to GPS monitoring if she were to post bail," said District Attorney Morrissey. "The judge imposed a \$20,000 cash bail and declined to impose electronic monitoring."

ADA Yas had argued for higher bail by citing Schwartz's actions in the five days following the shooting, during which she did not go home and changed location repeatedly, and prior history of defaulting on court dates.

"Judge Flynn ordered that she return to court February 18 for a probable cause hearing," Morrissey said.

The shooter remains at-large.
