Quincy man gets 5 to 9 years in 2010 rape

Enwu Li, age 24, with past addresses on Billings Street in North Quincy and Highland Ave in Quincy, was found guilty of two counts of rape and one count of indecent assault and battery on a person over the age of 14 by a Norfolk Superior Court jury on February 6, 2014.

The convictions came after an almost two-week trial. Assistant District Attorney Jennifer Blair asked Judge Thomas Connors to sentence Li to 12 to 15 years in state prison. He was sentenced to 5 to 9 years in state prison to be followed by 6 years of probation supervision.

Li attacked a woman whom he knew through his employment at a Boston hair salon when that woman helped him transport some hair styling equipment to his Billings Street home on December 6, 2010.

The rape was reported to Quincy Police ten days later. "Quincy Police and specifically Detective John Menz put in a great deal of good work to put this case together and assemble all of the evidence possible, and it gave us a solid case to bring to trial," District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey said. "The victim has since moved from the Boston area, but she returned and gave testimony at this trial. In doing so has made it possible for a dangerous man to face just punishment. We thank her for her courage and her strength."
