Weymouth driver ordered held without bail

Thomas A. Mohan, 51, of Weymouth, was ordered held without bail after pleading not guilty to five charges at a bedside arraignment at South Shore Hospital today (February 24, 2016), according to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey.

Mohan pled not guilty to Operating Under the Influence of Alcohol, Negligently, causing Serious Bodily Injury, Operating Under the Influence of Drugs, Negligently, causing Serious Bodily Injury, Negligent Operation of Motor Vehicle and Failing to Keep to Marked Lanes.

Assistant Norfolk District Attorney Michael Pirrello asked Judge Kevin J. O'Dea to revoke Mohan's bail on a Hingham District Court case involving the violation of a restraining order; that motion was allowed, meaning he will be held without bail for 90 days. ADA Pirrello also requested an additional \$25,000 cash bail on the new charges, with conditions of release including no driving during pendency of case and drug and alcohol abstinence with testing. Judge O'Dea ordered \$15,000 bail on the new charges with the requested conditions.

Mohan was ordered to appear in the Quincy District Court on March 22, 2016 for pre-trial conference.

As with all criminal defendants, this defendant enjoys the constitutional presumption of innocence unless and until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.

The pedestrian injured in the incident remains hospitalized with multiple major traumatic injuries.
