SJC Affirms Wellesley Domestic murder conviction

Massachusetts' highest court today (March 14, 2013) upheld the Norfolk Superior Court murder conviction of Dirk Greineder in the October 1999 murder of his spouse Mabel Greineder by Morse's Pond in Wellesley.

The following is the statement Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey released responsive to press inquiries following the Supreme Judicial Court opinion was released:

Today's decision re-affirms that Mabel Greineder was the victim of a brutal domestic violence murder at the hands of her husband Dirk, the fairness of his trial and that the verdict was just. I happened to be with Wellesley Chief Cunningham when the decision was released, and we are both pleased and relieved that the good work of his department, the State Police detectives attached to the district attorney's office, and the assistant district attorneys who worked on this case and appeal have delivered this just result.
