Guilty plea in highly Publicized case

Eric Tyrrell, 29, of Foxboro pled guilty on April 18, 2019, to both indictments of receiving stolen property valued over \$250, according to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey.

Tyrrell was charged as part of the overall investigation into the burglary of a home owned by a standout member of the New England Patriots football team, DA Morrissey said. "He was not charged with breaking into the home, and indeed the available evidence does not suggest that he did. He was charged with having, and pawning, coins stolen from the residence," Morrissey said.

Tyrrell was sentenced to 2 years of probation by Judge Robert Cosgrove, with probation conditions including that he stay away from and have no contact with the named victim or the residence.
