Not guilty plea in man accused of Accessory after the fact of murder

A 24-year-old Weymouth man has been arrested and charged with accessory after the fact to the murder of Ryan Martin in Weymouth on May 7, 2020, Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey and Weymouth Police Chief Richard M. Fuller announced.

Shawn Inglis, of 590 Middle Street in Weymouth, was arrested Friday afternoon and arraigned remotely by Quincy District Court Judge Mary Orfanello at 4:30 p.m. Judge Orfanello set \$25,000 cash bail. Should Inglis post his cash bail, Judge Orfanello ordered that he should stay away from and have no contact with Kelsey Debello, the woman who has pled not guilty to murdering Ryan Martin.

Inglis is due back in Quincy District Court on June 18, 2020. He was represented by Attorney Lawrence Kelly.

In arguing for bail, Assistant District Attorney Carolyn Hely told Judge Orfanello that the basis for the charge is Inglis' actions transporting Debello away from the area of the murder, housing her overnight, and disposing of certain items of evidence.

All defendants are presumed innocent until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
