Brookline Restaurateur pleads not guilty To secretly filming women in the bathroom

A Weston man has pled not guilty to 15 counts of secretly recording women while they used the bathroom at his Brookline restaurant.

Tze Ping "Andy" Chung, 63, of North Ave in Weston, is accused of using a secret camera to record women at the Taam China restaurant on Harvard Street in Brookline. He was arrested yesterday on a warrant obtained by Brookline police following an investigation. He pled not guilty to violating Ch. 272 Sec. 105 (b).

Assistant District Attorney Moira Daly asked Judge Mary Dacey White to hold Chung on \$25,000 cash bail, order him to surrender his passport (unless it had been surrendered in Middlesex County prosecution), not seek duplicative passport, stay away from the Taam China restaurant in Brookline, stay away from and have no contact with any victims should others be identified, and submit to GPS monitoring with an exclusion zone of town of Brookline.

Judge White ordered \$7,500 cash bail, stay away from the victim, not seek duplicative passport (defendant had surrendered in Middlesex), GPS monitoring with exclusion zone of Taam China and a 100 yard perimeter around that address.

He was ordered to return to court 7/17/18 for pretrial conference.

As with all defendants, Mr. Chung enjoys the Constitutional presumption of innocence unless and until he is proven guilty.
