BRANDON SPIKES PLEADS GUILTY

Brandon Spikes was in Wrentham District Court today for a clerk's hearing in connection with the hit and run crash which occurred on Sunday, June 7, 2015 on I-495 in Foxborough.

The Massachusetts State Police filed charges against Spikes which were heard today before a clerk magistrate of the Wrentham District Court. After the clerk's hearing, in which probable cause was found to issue criminal charges against Spikes, he waived his right to formal notice and process. Spikes immediately went into the first session of Wrentham District Court and admitted to the following charges and received the following disposition:

- Leaving the scene of personal injury Guilty 1 year probation;
- Negligent operation of a motor vehicle Continued without a finding (CWOF) 1 year;
- Operating an uninsured vehicle Continued without a finding (CWOF) 1 year;
- Speeding (civil offense) responsible file;
- Marked lanes violation (civil offense) responsible file;

The Honorable Stephen Ostrach of the Wrentham District Court presided over the arraignment and sentencing. Brandon Spikes was represented by Attorney Christopher Belezos and the Commonwealth was represented by Assistant District Attorney Adam Lally.
