Victim in July 4th Stabbing has Died

Shortly before 7 p.m. on July 4th, Quincy Police were called to the area of 10 South Central Avenue on a report of a stabbing at that location.

Mr. Biqiang He, age 55, of 67 W. Newton Street in Boston, was transported from the scene first to Quincy Medical Center, then to Boston Medical Center where he underwent surgery.

Following investigation at the scene, Quincy Police arrested Mr. He's wife, Huixian Liu, age 46, also of 67 W. Newton Street in Boston, for the stabbing. Because of the seriousness of the injuries, Quincy Police also contacted the State Police homicide detectives assigned to the Norfolk District Attorney's Office to enter the investigation.

Ms. Liu entered a plea of not guilty at her Quincy District Court on Friday and was ordered held without bail pending a dangerousness hearing on Friday, July 12.

Mr. He passed away at Boston Medical Center yesterday afternoon (Sunday.) The Office of the Chief Medical Examiner has accepted the case for autopsy, but that process has not been completed at this hour. Prosecutors will examine the existing assault charges in light of the victim's death, and the information revealed by the autopsy, in advance of her Friday court appearance.

July 12, 2019 arraignment update: Liu pled not guilty at her arraignment before the Hon. Paula Clifford. Assistant District Attorney Greg Connor asked that she be held without bail on the murder charge. That request was granted. She is due back in QDC on 8/13/19 for a probable cause hearing. Defense attorney was Thomas Ford.
