Two indicted in February crash That killed Needham teens

A Norfolk County Grand Jury has indicted a Needham man and a Wellesley woman in the February 10, 2018 collision that killed two Needham pedestrians.

Robert Berry, 65, of Needham, was indicted on three charges: Negligent Motor Vehicle Homicide and two counts of Aggravated Assault and Battery with a Dangerous Weapon.

Dania Antoine-Guiteau, 52, of Wellesley, was indicted for Manslaughter and Negligent Motor Vehicle Homicide.

The crash claimed the lives of Needham High School students Talia Newfield, 16, and Adrienne Garrido, 17. They were walking on Webster Street when they were struck, not far from their high school.

No Norfolk Superior Court arraignment date has yet been set. (Arraignment was subsequently scheduled for September 5, 2018 at 2 p.m.)

Pending charges represent accusations; all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt under the United States Constitution
