TUERK INDICTED IN WIFE'S MURDER

Ingolf Tuerk, 58, of Valley Rd., Dover, Mass, has been indicted by a Norfolk County Grand Jury for the murder of his wife in May of this year, according to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey.

Kathleen McLean, 45, was last seen alive on Thursday, May 14, in the home she shared with Tuerk. Her remains were found days later by Dover and State Police investigators in a small pond not far from the couple's home.

"This indictment moves the case to the Norfolk Superior Court, where it can proceed toward trial," District Attorney Morrissey said.

District Attorney Morrissey thanked the investigators from the Dover Police Department, Massachusetts State Police, and the Dedham Police Department for their work on this investigation.

"The indictment was returned today – we will work with defense counsel to schedule an arraignment in the coming weeks," Morrissey said. "Until then, Mr. Tuerk remains held without bail."
