Randolph man pleads not guilty to indecent assault

Kevin Harrison, of Randolph, was arraigned Wednesday Sept. 5 before Quincy District Court Judge John Stapleton.

He entered a plea of not guilty to three charges brought by Randolph PD: Two counts of Indecent Assault and Battery on a person over 14 and one count of Open and Gross Lewdness.

Assistant District Attorney Rita Muse asked the Court to impose at \$5,000 cash bail with conditions to include an order that the defendant stay away from and have no contact with the named victim, that he stay away from and have no contact with children under 18 and comply with any/all orders by the Department of Children and Families. He was released on his personal recognizance with the condition that he stay away and have no contact with the victim.

The Commonwealth's motion to redact identifying victim information and an accompanying protective order for that information were allowed, consistent with MGL Chap. 41 Sec. 97d. An attorney from CPCS was appointed for bail purposes only, as defendant indicated he would be hiring a private attorney.

He is due to return to Quincy District Court 10/21/19.
