## **Grand Jury indicts wife for Manslaughter in July 4 stabbing**

A Norfolk County grand jury today indicted a Boston woman for the July 4th stabbing death of her husband in Quincy, according to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey.

"The grand jury was presented with the evidence developed by Quincy and Massachusetts State Police detectives investigating the incident and today returned an indictment for manslaughter," District Attorney Morrissey said (on September 26, 2019). "This will move the case to the Superior Court, where we expect an arraignment at 2 p.m. on October 3, 2019."

Quincy Police were called to the area of 10 South Central Avenue on a report of a stabbing shortly before 7 p.m. on July 4. Mr. Biqiang He, age 55, of 67 West Newton Street in Boston was transported from the scene to Quincy Medical Center, then to Boston Medical Center. He underwent surgery but passed away from his injuries three days later.

His wife, Huixian Liu, age 47, also of 67 West Newton Street, Boston pled not guilty to charges in the case in July and has been held without bail since that time. The case is being prosecuted by Assistant Norfolk District Attorney Greg Connor.

As in all criminal cases, Ms. Liu enjoys the presumption of innocence until proven guilty under the U.S. Constitution.
