Man indicted for murder, woman for accessory in July shooting

A Norfolk County Grand Jury has indicted Myles King, 21, of Milton, for the July 10, 2021 murder of Marquis Simmons, and a woman reported to be in a relationship with King has been indicted as an accessory after the fact of the murder, according to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey.

King was arrested the day after the murder following an investigation by Milton Police and Massachusetts State Police detectives assigned to Norfolk District Attorney Michael W. Morrissey's Office. He entered a plea of not guilty at his Quincy District Court arraignment following his arrest and was ordered held without bail. His

"The indictment issued Friday moves the matter to Norfolk Superior Court, where it will be prosecuted by Assistant District Attorney Adam Lally," District Attorney Morrissey said. "Mr. King was indicted for first-degree Murder, Carrying a firearm without a license, carrying a loaded firearm without a license, and possession of a large capacity firearm. Ms. Bryanna Gardener has been indicted for Accessory After the Fact of murder. The Superior Court has not yet set an arraignment date." Gardener will be summonsed to her arraignment.

Marquis Simmons had traveled by moped to the Belvoir Road area of Milton just around 6 p.m. on July 10 and dismounted that vehicle. He was shot a few yards from where he had parked. He was rushed to Boston Medical Center but did not survive.

King is represented by defense attorney Rosemary C. Scapicchio.

All defendants are presumed innocent until proven quilty beyond a reasonable doubt.
